

Our School History

VICTORY HOUSE

was born out of a vision to provide quality education, based on Christian principles, at an affordable rate. This dream was realised in 1997 when the school first opened its doors as *ATHENA PREPARATORY*, under the leadership of the founders and Principals, Mrs. Austen and Mrs. Cloete. The school started with 18 learners ranging from Grade 0 to Grade 4 but has since experienced a phenomenal growth.

By January 2000 the school had 165 learners from Grade 0 to Grade 7, with 10 staff-members, highlighting the real need to expand into a HIGH SCHOOL.

This created many challenges but we believed that it would give us the opportunity to continue having a positive influence on the lives of each learner at the school. It was felt that the growth into a High School would meet each young adult's need and prepare them for life's challenges after school.

The High School was launched at the beginning of 2001 with our first group of Matriculants, matriculating at the end of 2005

Victory House accepts children of any religion and culture and aims to provide a secure environment in which they are best able to reach their potential in all areas.

We have established ourselves as a school which places emphasis on academic achievements whilst providing a disciplined, nurturing environment, where learning can become a satisfying experience.

The name VICTORY embodies the spirit and focus of our school. The decision to rename the school once the High School began was as an acknowledgement of our aspiration to "lean the entire human personality upon God in absolute trust and confidence in His power, wisdom and goodness".

At the end of 2004 Mrs. Cloete decided that due largely to the demands placed on her by her own growing family that she would

sell her interest in the school to Mrs. Austen.

The school has since continued under the able leadership of Mrs. Austen together with her Management team.

Our Educational Vision

We, as educators, set out to develop each child's natural talents, impart new skills and encourage them to fulfil their potential in all areas - academic, emotional, spiritual and physical. In so doing, we hope to promote the development of well-rounded individuals who are able to both meet life's challenges and present the world as we know it, with new ones. We recognise the diversity of each child's abilities & natural talents and therefore endeavour to instil in the child an appreciation of knowledge, art, culture and a sense of community. We encourage the children to realise that they can be victorious. The importance of guiding and directing each child towards his/her goals is paramount. 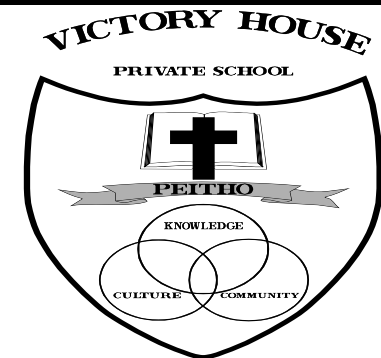
